William Fowler "Bubba" Moore was a larger-than-life member of our community dedicated to giving back to the Brazos Valley community he loved until his death April 3, 2004. Some remember Bubba as the "Man in the Glass House" at Post Oak Mall vowing to raise \$150,000 for Habitat for Humanity. For this and many other charitable efforts he was awarded a 2004 Jefferson Award.

As an extension and legal entity to this means, the Friends of Bubba formed a nonprofit, charitable organization called Bubba Moore Memorial Group, Inc. (BMMG). Our purpose includes helping local charities and financially disadvantaged citizens in need of medical and/or living expenses during a medical crisis.

Since 2005, BMMG has donated over \$175,000.00 to our local community to include: Health for All Clinic, Hospice Brazos Valley (both of which service seven surrounding counties), Twin City Mission, Still Creek Ranch, Scotty's House, Phoebe's House, Aggieland Pregnancy Outreach Inc., MHMR, St. Joseph's Foundation, The South Central National Spinal Cord Injury Foundation, The Coach G Foundation, and numerous local individuals in need.

In keeping with the goal of this organization, we are holding the Sixth Annual Friends of Bubba Golf Tournament on Saturday, October 1, 2011, at Briarcrest Country Club in Bryan, Texas.
